# ARTICLE F. INDUSTRIAL ZONE1

10-3F-1: USES PERMITTED:

Automobile wrecking yards.

Building material sales yard.

Contractor yard.

Manufacturing and warehousing.

One office or office trailer for a watchman in conjunction with a permitted use. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

10-3F-2: INDUSTRIAL BUFFER REQUIRED: Where an industrial use adjoins, faces or confronts a residential property or a major or secondary highway, such industrial use shall provide a yard of no less than ten percent (10%) of the lot depth or width on the side or sides abutting, facing, or confronting said uses, but such yard need not exceed fifty feet

<sup>1.</sup> Any and all new construction, if covered under ADA, shall meet with said requirements.

(50') unless a greater depth or width is required for storage or manufacturing of explosive or volatile products. A perimeter visual buffer wall or fence or screen not less than eight feet (8') in height is required. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

10-3F-3: **BUILDING HEIGHT:** Maximum building height, thirty five feet (35'). (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

10-3F-4: LOT AREA: No minimum. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

10-3F-5: LOT WIDTH: No minimum. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

10-3F-6: LOT AREA PER DWELLING UNIT: None. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

### 10-3F-7: YARDS:

A. Front Yard: None except as provided in section 10-3F-2 of this article.

B. Side Yard: None except as provided in section 10-3F-2 of this article.

 Rear Yard: None except as provided in section 10-3F-2 of this article. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)

10-3F-8: USES NOT PERMITTED: No residential use. (Ord. 04-07-003, 8-9-2003)
